- Visitors from different faiths

### Individual Liberty

- Children choosing their own learning activities in class
- Choosing library books
- Choosing from a wide range of extra-curricular clubs
- Encouraging a positive sense of self through growth mindset and self-regulation principles

### Democracy

- Encouraging children to know that their views count through paired partner talk, group and class discussions.
- School Council with representatives from each class chosen by a vote.
