


Mathematics—Number and Numerical Patterns

In Maths we will be developing our understanding of 1:1 correspondence and counting as well as ordering numbers 0 to 5. Using the mastery approach, we will begin exploring numbers: investigating value and different numbers that can make up the number we are focusing on.

We will be learning what number bonds create various numbers, for example 4=3+1 and 4=2+2.
